



### Infrastructure

#### THE COLLEGE CAMPUS

The widely expanded campus of the college is spread over 25000 Sq Yards of land set amidst scenic surroundings at Goner Road, Shri Ramchandrapura near Akshay Patra Temple, Jagatpura , Jaipur. Lawns, landscaped gardens and playgrounds surround the building, which houses modern classrooms and state-of-the-art laboratories. The main block of college is a four storey building with basement and incorporated with many features of a green building like rainwater harvesting system, water recycling plant etc. The transport facility from the main city is also easily available.

#### **GREEN CAMPUS**

Green campus is a core concept to build sustainable living practices that are environmental friendly in educational institutions around. Studies have shown that students studying on active green campuses have better knowledge retention capacity. Efforts are being made to develop the campus on green concepts, with special focus on water conservation, use of alternative sources of energy, green belt development and sustainable architectural designs of buildings. The lush green lawn area, a beautiful botanical garden, eye-catching perennial and flowering trees grown in beautiful manner in whole campus enhance the beauty of the campus. About 500 plants belonging to different species are maintained here.

#### THE ADMINISTRATION BLOCK

#### **RECEPTION**

A very magnificent reception area is the prime place for sorting out and solving all kinds of enquiries of students, parents, guardians and others. The college staff is available to resolve all the queries regarding counseling, admission procedure and other college related matters during working hours of the college. Counselors and the faculty members guide the students as per their needs, interests and capabilities.

#### THE ADMISSION CELL

A pre-admission counseling cell is set-up to answer queries and provide general admission guidelines to admission seekers. The members of admission counseling cell are available on working days between 9:00 am - 3:00 pm. The faculties of concerned subjects are acting members of the admission committee, to take care of admission and career related queries bubbling within the new students and their parents.

#### **ADMINISTRATION OFFICE**

The well-furnished Administration Office run by qualified and dedicated staff is the core center to streamline and systemize the functioning of the college. This also serves as the student's information center.

#### THE FACULTY ROOM

Faculty rooms are meant to build up a friendly, professional and efficient ambience. Our Faculty Room is perfect to create such an environment. A very spacious and properly ventilated space with various facilities like, computer system, Wi-Fi, locker and personal space are provided to each faculty member to keep their reference books, teaching materials and important stuff. The teachers work together to build better learning environment for students.

#### THE EXAMINATION CELL

The examination cell is working for smooth conduction of internal and external examinations. It also manages and organizes University Practical Examinations, viva-voce examinations for students of BBA/BCA by complying with guidelines of University of Rajasthan and coordinate with all faculty members to ensure credibility and stability of the examination system



# The Academic Block

Academic block is the centre where teachers and students can interact and exchange their thoughts, ideas and knowledge for better learning. The Institute has a separate Academic Block with 26 large classrooms, 13 laboratories, one air-conditioned Lecture Hall with seating capacity of 200, two smart classrooms and the faculty rooms. The walls of the Academic Block are adorned with many motivational quotations, beautiful paintings that make the ambience very inspirational. This block is utilized for organizing various conferences, seminars, guest lectures, faculty development programs and study programs, as per the needs of students and faculty members.

The Academic Block houses the following infrastructure:

#### **THE LIBRARY**

"Amidst the shelves of a college library, students embark on a journey of intellectual exploration, guided by the compass of literature and the constellations of knowledge."



The Learning Center, the library, is core to each student's academic progress. It was established in 2015, since then the library has made consistent progress in terms of collection of books, periodicals, eresources, services and provides reader friendly infrastructure. It has seating capacity for 100 students at a time.

At present, the library has over 5600 books and bound volumes of journals covering a wide variety of subjects.

Our library is therefore operated on a need based approach rather than the usual rules-based treatment given to students. In addition, we encourage students to read books, periodicals, reference books, journals and competitive magazines etc.

#### **CLASSIFICATION & CATALOGUING:**

The College library uses Dewey Decimal Classification Scheme for classifying the books. Classified catalogue code is used to prepare the catalogue entries in the library software.

#### **Easylib-Library Automation Software**

Easylib that stands for Entire Automation System for Libraries is an integrated system for library. It performs various functions related to library for improved operations. Library is fully automated using this commercial software. Bar coding is used for book circulation.

#### Reference Service

A well furnished Reference Section is maintained in the library where staff and students can pick the book of their choice and make reference. Important textbooks, Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, Reference Books, Multiple volume sets, Dissertations and Question paper sets etc. are displayed in this section.

Students and staff can read and refer to the Periodicals, for awareness about the day-to-day events, the library receives six leading newspapers, employment newspaper and the following magazines and journals:-

#### THE BOOKS & JOURNALS SECTION

The vast library houses a diverse collection of over 5600 books published by leading National and International Publishing Houses in disciplines of Science (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Botany and Geography), Commerce, Computer Science, Humanities, Business Administration and various Magazines, Other Motivational & Inspirational books.

#### **READING SECTION**

Reading is one of the best productive habits one could possess, it plays a vital role in our life. It broadens our minds with facts and informational pieces. Library has well lit and comfortable reading corners for faculty members and the students. The discipline and peace are maintained remarkably by well-trained senior library head and staff.



#### THE GLOBAL LIBRARY - for the Students by the Students

Self study is the best way of imbibing self-discipline and self management among an individual. Based on this concept, a special library, the Global Library "for the students by the students" was established. This small library is enriched with books on various subjects which are donated by the faculty members from time to time. It has a well planned infrastructure too for reading and seating. A few volunteer students run this small library and manage the accounting themselves.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR LIBRARY**

• Admittance: Students must present their identity cum library card and sign in/out at the register located at the library gate for entry.

- Library Card: Each student is issued one library card, and two books can be borrowed per card. Cards are non-transferable.
- Loan Period: Students can borrow books for 14 days, and if not requested by another student, they can be renewed for an additional 14 days.
- Overdue Books: Failure to return books within the stipulated period will result in a fine of Rs. 5 per day per book. Readers are responsible for books issued under their names.
- Book Recall: The library reserves the right to recall any issued book before the due date.
- Lost Books: If a borrowed book is lost, the borrower must replace it with a copy of the same or latest edition. Failure to replace the book will result in a fine double the cost of the book.
- Barcode Damage: Any damage caused to the barcode of a book will incur a fine of Rs. 100 per book, as the library is automated/ computerized.
- Lost Library ID: In case of a lost Library ID, a duplicate may be issued upon payment of Rs. 100.
- Personal Belongings: Personal items like bags and laptops are not allowed inside the library and should be deposited at the entrance.

#### SEMINAR HALL/AUDITORIUM

To enhance the quality of education and provide a conducive environment for various activities, the college's seminar halls and auditoriums offer state-of-the-art amenities and facilities. With a seating capacity of 400 each, these hi-tech venues are well-lit and equipped with luxurious seating arrangements.

The auditoriums boast modern features such as whiteboards, LCD projectors, and high-quality sound systems, catering to diverse educational needs. Additionally, one of the halls is fully air-conditioned, ensuring comfort for all participants. These versatile spaces serve as regular venues for a myriad of activities including exhibitions, workshops, seminars, presentations, and cultural events.

#### **CLASSROOM AND TUTORIAL ROOMS**

The Academic block boasts thirty spacious and well-lit classrooms, including two state-of-the-art lecture theaters accommodating up to 100 students each. Additionally, there are twenty-four lecture rooms with a capacity of 60-70 students and four tutorial rooms catering to 30 students each, providing an immersive and insightful learning environment for all students.

#### **SMART CLASSROOMS**

The college is outfitted with cutting-edge smart classrooms, revolutionizing the teaching and learning experience through innovative technology integration. These smart classrooms leverage engaging visuals and animations to elucidate complex concepts, fostering an enjoyable learning journey for students and enhancing their academic performance significantly.



#### **OUTDOOR SPORTS GROUND**

The college emphasizes the importance of sports and games as an integral component of the education process. Our sports facilities offer students a platform to not only improve their concentration but also maintain their physical and mental well-being. Nestled within our campus is a sprawling, lush green playground, equipped with facilities for a variety of sports including Tennis, Volleyball, Football, badminton, hockey, and many more, ensuring students have ample opportunities to engage in physical activities and develop essential life skills.



#### **PARKING AREA**

Adequate parking facilities cater to both faculty and students, accommodating over 300 vehicles simultaneously. Enhanced security measures include 24-hour CCTV surveillance and a dedicated team of 2 to 3 guards ensuring the safety of parked vehicles around the clock.

## **Amenities**

#### **LABORATORIES**

Science, being a practical subject, cannot be effectively taught solely through theory. To ensure proper science education, various experimental works must be conducted. Science laboratories are central to this instruction and are essential components of science education. It is within these facilities that students carry out practical experiments, crucial for their learning. Without well-equipped laboratories, the science teaching process cannot be effectively carried out in any educational institution. At S.S. Jain Subodh College of Global Excellence, we boast well-equipped labs with advanced instruments catering to all science subjects (Botany, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, and Zoology), meeting both student expectations and the curriculum standards of the University of Rajasthan.



#### **PHYSICS LAB**

"The laws of physics are the canvas on which God has laid the foundation for painting his masterpiece."



- The department houses three well-established laboratories, each capable of accommodating 30 students at a time. These labs are equipped with ample space, allowing students to work freely.
- The Physics Lab is designed to train students in assembling and operating apparatus, collecting and interpreting data, and presenting experiment results in written reports.
- The laboratories are well-equipped with a wide array of instruments,

including a Geiger Muller Counter (GMC), Grating, Four Probe, LCR circuit, RC Transmission Line, Solar cell, Electronic Balance, Newton's Ring Apparatus, Carry Foster Bridge, Random Decay Apparatus, Rectifier, Filter circuits, Fresnel Bi-prism, Operational Amplifier, Black Body Radiation apparatus, Stefan's Constant apparatus, Compound Pendulum, Conversion of Galvanometer to Ammeter and Galvanometer to Voltmeter apparatus, Analog to Digital and Digital to Analog Converter, etc.

#### **CHEMISTRY LAB**

"Chemistry is the art of understanding the invisible dance of atoms, the poetry written in molecular bonds, and the symphony of elements that compose the beautiful composition of our world."

- The department houses three spacious laboratories, each capable of accommodating up to 30 students during practical classes.
- These labs are meticulously stocked with ample chemicals, ensuring every student has the opportunity to engage in hands-on experiments. Guided by dedicated and experienced faculty members.
- Furthermore, the laboratory infrastructure is continuously enhanced with the latest equipment and techniques, including Spectrophotometer, TDS meters, Vacuum pumps, Digital centrifuges, Digital balances, pH Meters, Double Distillation units, Magnetic Stirrers, Heating Mantles, and Digital Potentiometers. These modern tools not only enrich the learning experience but also bolster students experimental skills. Importantly, the department prioritizes student safety, implementing stringent measures to safeguard individuals while handling chemicals and instruments.



#### **ZOOLOGY LAB**

"Zoology is the grand narrative of life, where every organism tells a story of adaptation, evolution, and the intricate dance of nature. It's a journey into the remarkable diversity that paints the canvas of our living world."

- The department has two spacious and well-equipped laboratories with capacity of 30 students each to conduct practical classes
- All the laboratories have necessary infrastructure and equipment to conduct practical classes in the field of Molecular Biology, Biotechnology, and Ecology etc. prescribed as per syllabus
- The laboratory is equipped with diverse apparatus like Hot Air Oven, High Speed Centrifuge, Digital Balance, pH Meter, Binocular Microscope, Simple and Compound Microscope, Distillation Unit, Autoclave, Hot Plate, Water Bath, Colony Counter, Refrigerator, Heating Mantle, Microscopic Slides, Biological Charts and Posters. In the laboratory there is a large museum with well stocked syllabi wise specimens.

- Additionally, students have access to a vast museum housing meticulously curated specimens aligned with the syllabus, enriching their educational experience further.



#### **BOTANICAL GARDEN**

The purpose of creating a botanical garden is to provide an educational platform for our students to learn about plant collection, cultivation, and conservation. Continuous assessment, in which sessional work and the terminal examination will contribute to the final grade. Each course in Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) has two components- Continuous assessment (20% weightage) and (End of Semester Examination) EoSE (80% weightage).

- Sessional work will consist of class tests, mid-semester examination(s), homework assignments, etc., as determined by the faculty in charge of the courses of study.
- 2. Each Paper of EoSE shall carry 80% of the total marks of the course/subject. The EoSE will be of 3 hours duration.
- Part-A of the paper shall have multiple questions of equal marks. The first question shall be based on knowledge, understanding and applications of the topics/texts covered in the syllabus.
- Part B of the paper shall consist of 4 questions with an internal choice of each. The four questions will be set with one from each of the units with internal choice. Third to fourth questions shall be based on applications of the topics/texts covered in the syllabus (60 % weightage) and shall involve solving problems (40% weightage) if applicable.
- 3. 75% Attendance is mandatory for appearing in EoSE.
- To appear in the EoSE examination of a course/subject student must appear in the mid-semester examination and obtain at least C grade in the course/subject.
- 5. Credit points in a Course/Subject will be assigned only if, the student obtains at least a 'C grade' in midterm and EoSE examination of a Course/Subject.

- III. If a student secures a minimum of 48 credits in the first year, he/she will be promoted by the university with the remark "PASS" in the second year. If he/she wants to exit after first year with "CERTIFICATE OF FACULTY/DISCIPLINE" then a minimum of 48 credits from course and 4 credits from internship to be earned.
- IV. If the minimum number of credits acquired by the student in the first year is less than 48, then-
- On securing a minimum of 18 credits (50% of total credits 36 in core subjects) and a minimum of 26 credits (50% of total credits 52) in the first year will be promoted with the remark "BACK PROMOTED". In his second year, he can again earn the required credits by appearing in the relevant subjects of the first and second semesters.
- V. Otherwise, the student will become an EX-STUDENT with the remark "FAIL".
- VI. In any year the student cannot appear in all the examinations of any one semester of the previous year.
- VII. For promotion from the current year to the next year, it is mandatory to pass all the prescribed co-courses of the previous year with a minimum of C grades (40%).
- VIII. The maximum period to complete the first year is three years, and for this, the student must have earned a minimum of 48 credits.

- 3. Permission to appear in the Annual Examination will not be granted unless:
- A student obtains 75% attendance in each subject at the end of every academic session as per the university rules.
- A student gets at least minimum passing marks in the final examination conducted by University of Rajasthan.
- The Principal is satisfied with the character and conduct of the student throughout the year.
- Details of short attendance will be notified to the students timely, and students are advised to make up for the shortage caused by any reason.
- All disputes/legal matters shall be covered under Jaipur Jurisdiction only.

#### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

- Students shall compulsorily wear the prescribed college uniform on all working days, which can be obtained from the uniform distribution counter by showing the fee receipt. Students found without proper uniform will be charged with a fine of Rs 50.
- Every student must carry his/her identity card while entering the campus.
- No Guests/visitors shall be allowed with students in the class/lab/ library.
- 4. Students must conserve electricity and water. They must switch off the lights and fans when they leave the classrooms and laboratories.
- 5. Students must take proper care of college property. Vandalism and destruction of college property will be severely dealt with and material loss will be fully recovered with fine.
- 6. Scribbling and noting on walls, doors and furniture is strictly prohibited. If anyone is found guilty, he/she shall be punished as per the college norms.
- 7. No fund raising for any purpose shall be allowed without the Principal's permission. If anyone does so, he/she is liable for punishment under the disciplinary code.
- 8. College would not accept violence, exploitation, or harassment in any case by the students. It would be considered a crime and is punishable as per law.
- Organizing meetings in the college, distributing leaflets, handbills, or other materials, displaying banners and posters inside the campus without permission is not allowed. If any of this is necessary, then prior permission should be taken from the administration.
- 10. Students are not allowed to use mobile phones, gadgets, or any electronic equipments in the college campus. If found, they will be immediately confiscated.
- 11. Smoking, chewing tobacco, consumption of alcoholic beverages and use of narcotic drugs are strictly prohibited. Criminal proceedings

- will be taken against those found under the influence of alcohol or narcotic drugs within the campus. The college has zero tolerance policy on these matters.
- 12. Ragging is completely prohibited on and off the campus. If any candidate is found indulge in any form of ragging, he/she is liable to be punished as per the directive of the UGC and the Government.
- 13. Misconduct, bribing, cheating, or false declaration of any kind is not acceptable and is strictly prohibited.
- 14. It is mandatory for every student to inform the college if he/ she leaves the college in middle of the session.
- 15. Students will be allowed to bring their vehicles only up to the designated parking area. Entry beyond that point is strictly prohibited.
- 16. Students are strictly advised not to participate in any discussions, trolling or any such other kind of activities detrimental to the reputation of the college, departments, staff, and students. If any such activity comes to the notice of the Principal, the authority shall initiate appropriate legal action against such individuals.
- 17. At any stage, if it is found that a candidate has used some fraudulent means to seek admission, or has made incorrect statement(s), he/she shall not be granted admission or if already admitted, such admission shall be cancelled at any stage.
- During processing or verification of the documents, if any error or omission is found, the College has the right to cancel such kind of admissions.
- Late applications/incomplete applications/applications without requisite fee/application not submitted on the prescribed form shall not be entertained.
- 20. The College has not appointed any consultant or outside agency for admission. Candidates should remain cautious and directly contact to the Admission & Counseling Office for any query or assistance regarding admission.
- 21. Students are advised to follow the announcements on the notice boards.

#### STUDENT'S UNION ELECTION POLICY

The college prohibits political activities in the campus and forbids students from conducting student union election within the college campus.

#### INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

- Parents/guardians are requested to cooperate with the college authorities.
- The parents must see that their ward attends the college regularly. Their cooperation will improve the regularity and progress of the ward.
- 3. Parents are requested to make sure that their ward appears in class tests and Mid-Term Examination.
- 4. Parents/guardians are advised to check the records of the attendance of their ward to ensure that their ward is attending classes regularly.

According to the orders of the High Court, **all students must have 75%** attendance in the class to be eligible to appear as regular student in the University Examinations.
