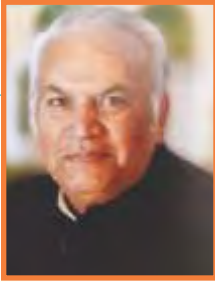

## INFRASTRUCTURE

### COLLEGE CAMPUS

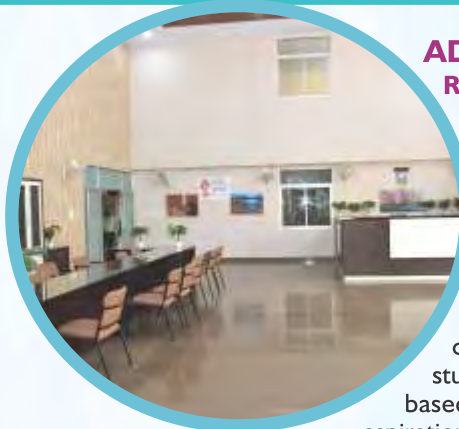
Spread across 25,000 square yards in the serene surroundings of Goner, Ramchandrapura, near the Akshay Patra Temple in Jagatpura, Jaipur, the college campus offers an ideal environment for academic excellence. The infrastructure features modern classrooms and advanced laboratories housed within a thoughtfully designed structure, complemented by landscaped gardens, open lawns, and a spacious playground.

The main academic block is a four-storey building with a basement, incorporating eco-conscious construction elements such as a water recycling plant and an efficient rainwater harvesting system. The campus also enjoys convenient connectivity to the main areas of the city.

### GREEN CAMPUS

The institution is committed to sustainable development and eco-friendly practices. Focused initiatives include water conservation, adoption of alternative energy sources, green belt development, and environmentally responsible architectural design.

The campus presents a visually appealing landscape with expansive green lawns, a well-maintained botanical garden, and a variety of flowering trees thoughtfully planted across the premises. Nearly 500 plant species are carefully nurtured, reflecting the college's dedication to environmental management.



### ADMINISTRATION BLOCK RECEPTION

The reception area is an impressive and welcoming space designed to efficiently address and resolve queries from students, parents, guardians, and visitors. Dedicated staff members are available during college working hours to assist with matters related to admissions, counselling, and other academic concerns. Faculty members and counsellors provide personalised guidance to students, helping them make informed decisions based on their abilities, interests, and career aspirations.

### ADMISSION CELL

The Admission Cell functions as a pre-admission counselling unit to respond to inquiries and provide comprehensive guidance to prospective students. The cell operates on working days from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. To ensure clarity regarding admissions and career pathways, faculty members from respective departments actively participate as members of the admission committee.

### ADMINISTRATION OFFICE

The Administration Office serves as the central hub for coordinating and managing the institution's operations. Equipped with modern facilities and supported by experienced and dedicated staff, it ensures smooth functioning of administrative processes. It also acts as an important information center for students.

### FACULTY ROOM

The Faculty Room is thoughtfully designed to foster a professional and collaborative work environment. It is spacious and well-ventilated, equipped with computer systems, Wi-Fi connectivity, lockers, and dedicated storage space for faculty members to organize teaching materials, reference books, and other essentials. The space encourages interaction and teamwork, ultimately enhancing the learning experience for students.

### EXAMINATION CELL

The Examination Cell ensures the smooth and systematic conduct of both internal and external examinations. It oversees the organization of University Practical and Viva-Voice examinations for BBA and BCA students. The cell works in close coordination with faculty members to maintain transparency, reliability, and adherence to the norms and guidelines prescribed by the University of Rajasthan.

## ACADEMIC BLOCK

The Academic Block serves as the intellectual hub of the institution, playing a vital role in fostering knowledge and academic excellence. It provides an enriching environment that encourages meaningful interaction between students and faculty, promoting effective learning.

The block comprises 26 spacious classrooms, 13 well-equipped laboratories, two air-conditioned lecture halls with a seating capacity of 200 each, two smart classrooms, and a dedicated faculty room. The interiors are thoughtfully enhanced with motivational quotations and artistic displays, creating an inspiring and engaging academic atmosphere.

The Academic Block encompasses the following facilities:

## LIBRARY

### CLASSIFICATION & CATALOGUING:

The College library follows the Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) system for systematic organization of books. A classified catalogue code is employed to prepare and maintain catalogue entries through the library management software, ensuring easy accessibility and efficient retrieval of resources.

### EASYLIB – LIBRARY AUTOMATION SOFTWARE

The library is fully automated using Easylib (Entire Automation System for Libraries), an integrated software solution designed to streamline library operations. It efficiently manages various functions related to cataloguing, circulation, and record maintenance. Barcode technology is utilised to facilitate smooth and accurate book transactions.

### REFERENCE SERVICE

The library maintains a well-furnished reference section where students and staff can consult a wide range of academic resources. This section includes important textbooks, encyclopaedias, dictionaries, reference materials, multi-volume sets, dissertations, and previous years' question papers, providing comprehensive academic support.

### BOOKS & JOURNALS SECTION

The library houses a rich and diverse collection of over 6,000 books published by reputed national and international publishers. The collection spans multiple disciplines including Science (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Botany and Geography), Commerce, Computer Science, Humanities, and Business Administration. In addition, the library subscribes to various journals, magazines and a range of motivational and inspirational literature.

Libraries serve as gateways to knowledge, culture, and intellectual growth. The resources and services offered create valuable opportunities for learning, strengthen literacy, and inspire innovative thinking that contributes to a progressive society. Established in 2015, the library has steadily expanded its collection of books, journals, periodicals, and e-resources while maintaining a reader-friendly environment. It accommodates up to 100 students at a time.

The library follows a need-based approach, prioritizing students' academic requirements rather than rigid rules. Students are encouraged to explore books, reference materials, journals, periodicals and competitive magazines to broaden their knowledge and enhance their learning experience.

### READING SECTION

The Reading Section serves as a dedicated space for focused study and meaningful discussions. It encourages leadership, research orientation, academic excellence and the exchange of ideas. By providing access to diverse informational resources, it helps broaden perspectives and strengthen critical thinking. The library offers well-lit, comfortable and peaceful reading corners for both faculty members and students.

### GLOBAL LIBRARY - for the Students by the Students

Self-study nurtures self-discipline, responsibility, and independent learning. With this philosophy in mind, the Global Library was established as a unique initiative “for the students, by the students.” This student-driven library features a thoughtfully arranged reading and seating space. It is enriched with books from various subjects, generously contributed by faculty members from time to time. Dedicated student volunteers manage the daily operations and maintain the records, fostering leadership, teamwork and accountability while promoting a culture of shared learning.



## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR LIBRARY

**Admittance:** Students must show their identity cum library card and sign in/out at the register located at the library gate for entry.

**Library Card:** One library card is given to each student, and each card can be used to borrow two books. Cards cannot be transferred.

**Loan Period:** Students can borrow books for 14 days, and if not requested by another student, they can be renewed for an additional 14 days.

**Overdue Books:** Failure to return books within the stipulated period will result in a fine of Rs. 5 per day per book. Readers are responsible for books issued under their names.

**Book Recall:** The library reserves the right to recall any issued book before the due date.

**Lost Books:** If a borrowed book is lost, the borrower must replace it with a copy of the same or latest edition. Failure to replace the book will result in a fine double the cost of the book.

**Barcode Damage:** Any damage caused to the barcode of a book will incur a fine of Rs. 100 per book, as the library is automated/computerised.

**Lost Library ID:** In case of a lost Library ID, a duplicate may be issued upon payment of Rs. 100.

**Personal Belongings:** Personal items like bags and laptops are not allowed inside the library and should be deposited at the entrance.



## SEMINAR HALL/ AUDITORIUM

In addition to being an excellent means of communication, deliberation is essential to the growth and improvement of both the person and the educational system overall. Modern facilities and amenities are available in the college's auditorium and seminar hall, with 400 seating capacity these state-of-the-art arenas are lavishly furnished and well-lit.

To meet a variety of instructional demands, the auditoriums are equipped with contemporary features including LCD projectors, whiteboards, and top-notch sound systems. A wide range of events, such as conferences, workshops, lectures, presentations and cultural events, frequently take place in these adaptable facilities.

## CLASSROOM AND TUTORIAL ROOMS

The Academic block has thirty large, bright classrooms, including two cutting-edge lecture halls that can hold up to 100 people each.

Additionally, there are four tutorial rooms that can accommodate 30 students each and twenty-four lecture rooms that can accommodate 60–70 students, all of which contribute to an engaging and enlightening learning environment for all students.

## SMART CLASSROOMS

The institution offers smart classrooms to accommodate the intelligent new generation and stay up to date with technological advancements in teaching technique while creating an exciting learning environment. By using captivating images and animations to clarify difficult ideas, these smart classrooms give students a fun educational experience and greatly improve their academic achievement.



## OUTDOOR SPORTS GROUND



Playing games is a vital part of maintaining a healthy body and mind. Recognising the value of sports, the college has a large outdoor playing field with facilities for a range of sports, such as Football, Badminton, Hockey, Tennis, Volleyball and many more. This ensures that students have plenty of chances to be active and acquire vital life skills.



## PARKING AREA

Faculty and students can park in a large, well-guarded lot that can hold more than 300 vehicles at once. CCTV surveillance is available around-the-clock, and a specialised crew of two to three guards is on duty to ensure the protection of parked vehicle.



## COMMON ROOM

Both boys and girls have their own common rooms at our institute. Engaging gathering places for leisure activities, these areas promote conversations about a range of subjects related to students' interests. Students rejuvenate here and participate in productive activities including discussing topics, exchanging ideas and organising extracurricular activities. Both common rooms are overseen by the discipline committee under the leadership of the Head of the Institute.

## CANTEEN/CAFETERIA

In the College Canteen, students can enjoy a spacious, clean, and hygienic environment while indulging in a variety of delicious dishes. Quality food is prepared under strict hygiene conditions. At the canteen, we aim to ignite the passion for growth by offering an energetic and vibrant culinary experience, all at concessional prices.



## GYMNASIUM

A key factor in the fight against many diseases is the mutually beneficial interaction between health and fitness. There is a state-of-the-art gym at our campus, complete with the newest workout gear and a health education training area. Numerous aerobic and bodybuilding equipment's are available in the gym, such as electronic cycles, cross trainers, fully automated treadmills, weights and rods, triceps bars and multipurpose benches.



## INDOOR GAMES

Excellent facilities for indoor sports like Badminton, Table Tennis, Carom, and Chess are available at our college's indoor stadium. Students get the chance to play these games after class, creating an atmosphere that is supportive to their overall growth.

## AMENITIES

### LABORATORIES

The first practical experience a student has in their profession is working in a laboratory. Colleges place a greater emphasis on advanced coursework through hands-on experience. Depending on the kind of work or experiments, laboratories contain a variety of design elements. The college has well-equipped labs with the newest equipment for all science courses (Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, Physics and Geography) as well as a computer science lab with the newest hardware & software and commerce lab that meet the requirements of the University of Rajasthan curriculum and students' expectations.



### PHYSICS LAB

*"Physics whispers the rules, but curiosity asks the right questions."*

- The Department has three well established laboratories each capable of accommodating a capacity of 30 students. These labs are intended to educate students the fundamental ideas and concepts of physics that are connected to lab experiments and their uses.
- Laboratory is well equipped with instrument's including a Geiger Muller Counter, Grating Spectrum, Four Probe, LCR circuit, RC Transmission Line, Solar cell, Electronic Balance, Newton's Ring Apparatus, Carry Foster Bridge, Random Decay Apparatus, Rectifier, Filter circuits, Fresnel Bi-prism, Operational Amplifier, Black Body Radiation apparatus, Stefan's Constant apparatus, Compound Pendulum, Conversion of Galvanometer to Ammeter and Galvanometer to Voltmeter apparatus, Analog to Digital and Digital to Analog Converter, etc.

### CHEMISTRY LAB

*"Impossible only means that you haven't found the solution yet."*

- The department has three large laboratories that may accommodate up to 30 students during practical lessons. Our labs are well-stocked with chemicals, allowing students to do hands-on investigations under the guidance of experienced faculty members.
- The laboratory infrastructure is constantly updated with procedures and cutting edge equipment, including Spectrophotometer, TDS meters, Vacuum pumps, Digital centrifuges, Digital balances, pH Meters, Double Distillation units, Magnetic Stirrers, Heating Mantles and Digital Potentiometers. These new technologies not only improve the learning experience, but they also help students to develop their experimental abilities. Importantly, the department promotes student safety, putting in place strong safeguards to protect persons when handling chemicals and instruments.



### ZOOLOGY LAB

*"Zoology is the excellent place to study habits of all human beings. It is not just the study of species but it is the study of life in all forms."*

- The department contains two spacious and well-equipped laboratories with capacity of 30 students each to conduct practical lessons. The laboratories have the essential infrastructure and equipment for practical sessions in Molecular Biology, Biotechnology, and Ecology, as per the syllabus.
- The laboratory has a variety of equipment, including Hot Air Oven, High Speed Centrifuge, Digital Balance, pH Meter, Binocular Microscope, Simple and Compound Microscope, Distillation Unit, Autoclave, Hot Plate, Water Bath, Colony Counter, Refrigerator, Heating Mantle, Microscopic Slides, Biological Charts and Posters. In the laboratory, there is a big museum with well-stocked syllabi-related exhibits.

## BOTANY LAB

*"Nothing tests your patience like waiting for a seed to germinate for a graded assignment."*

- There are two advanced labs in the department that can hold up to 30 students at once. These large, well-ventilated spaces are equipped with comprehensive array of equipment's including Spectrophotometers, Digital Balances, Centrifuges, Autoclaves, Laminar Air Flows, Microtomes, Ganong's Potometer, Respirometers, Digital pH Meters, Hot Plates, Incubator, Auxanometer, Binocular Microscopes, Microscopic Slides, Biological Charts and Posters
- Students' educational experience is further enhanced by having access to a large museum that has carefully chosen exhibits that are in line with the curriculum.



## GEOGRAPHY LAB

*"Geography is the tapestry that weaves the world together."*



A well-stocked laboratory with all the maps, charts, and other tools required to teach geography is maintained by the Department of Geography. Students whether individually or in groups, utilise these resources to solve geographical problems. Additionally, the laboratory facilitates the transformation of field-collected data or statistical report and diagrams

## COMMERCE LAB

The Commerce Lab offers real-world, hands-on business and commerce study opportunities and is built to accommodate large groups of students. It has cutting-edge technology, such as computers, LCD Projector and instruments for marketing, entrepreneurship, and financial analysis. Participation in stock market simulations, market research and project collaboration are all encouraged in this area. The design of the lab facilitates both individual and group work, enabling teachers to efficiently direct and supervise operations.



## BOTANICAL GARDEN

- A wide variety of plant species, including therapeutic ones, may be found in our garden such as Tinospora cordifolia and Aloe vera, as well as ornamental plants like Dahlia and Ixora. In addition to our greenhouse and shade house, we have incorporated a picturesque artificial pond which not only adds to the garden's natural beauty but also offers students who are interested in aquatic biology useful study materials.

## COMPUTER LAB

Two cutting-edge computer labs with LCD projectors, Wi-Fi, and a centralised server system linked to a local area network (LAN) are maintained by the department. Up to 100 students can be accommodated in each lab. 2. The selected students must meet admission committee with all prescribed documents, within the stipulated time mentioned in the merit list.
3. All admissions are subject to the approval by the University of Rajasthan.

## FEES SUBMISSION

1. Candidates must deposit the required fee at the respective fee counter to the college through following ways:
  - (i) Demand Draft / Pay Order of any bank in Favour of "Principal, S. S. Jain Subodh College of Global Excellence" payable at Jaipur.
  - (ii) Online Fee can be deposited through Net banking/Credit Card/Debit Card/UPI by link given on college website:

**Note: Fee once deposited, will not be refunded in any condition.**

2. Students are advised to write their Form No., Name, Father's Name, Class and Contact number on the back of the Demand Draft / Pay Order.
3. After admission in a particular stream, changing from one stream to the another stream shall be made after giving proper application in prescribed format, only if the marks obtained in the qualifying examination (10+2) are higher than that of the students last admitted in the class or if there is a seat vacant in the respective stream.
4. After admission, a student can change one subject and that too only once, if particular subject/subject combination has vacant seats. The change can be done within 15 days from the date of admission with a fee of Rs 300/- for the same.

### RULES AND REGULATION REGARDING FEES-

1. It is mandatory for all the students to deposit the fees within stipulated time and if he/she is unable to do so, his/her registration from the college will be cancelled.
2. It is mandatory to deposit full fee irrespective of the fact that he/she has taken the admission in beginning or during the session.
3. The fee has to be deposited only in one time, which includes the fees of the session and caution money.

4. The student has to pay extra fee if he/ she opts Geography.
5. The fee once deposited will not be refunded in any condition except caution money.
6. The caution money deposited by the students at the time of admission at the College shall be refunded through account payee cheque only. If any student, in a year, is unable to collect the cheque then his amount will be transferred to Student Alumni Fund.
7. All the disputes are subject to Jaipur Jurisdiction only.

## PROMOTION TO HIGHER CLASSES

1. Promotion to a higher class is not automatic and depends on the student's academic performance, character, and behaviour during the previous years.
2. The college will conduct continuous and comprehensive evaluations through monthly tests and Mid-Term exams.
3. To be eligible to appear for the Annual Examination, the following conditions must be met:
  - The student must maintain at least 75% attendance in each subject by the end of the academic year, as per University regulations.
  - The student must secure the minimum passing marks in the final examination conducted by the University of Rajasthan.
  - The Principal must be satisfied with the student's conduct and character throughout the academic year.
4. Any student with short attendance will be notified in a timely manner, and they are expected to compensate for any absences.
5. All legal disputes or matters will be subject to the jurisdiction of Jaipur only.

## CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Students must wear the prescribed college uniform on all working days. The uniform can be obtained from the distribution counter by presenting the fee receipt. A fine of Rs 50 will be imposed on students not wearing the college uniform.
2. Students must carry their identity card while entering the campus.
3. No guests or visitors are allowed in classrooms, laboratories and the library.
4. Students must conserve electricity and water by ensuring that lights and fans are turned off when leaving classrooms and laboratories.
5. Students are expected to take care of college property. Any damage to property will result in a fine, and strict disciplinary action will be taken.

6. Writing or marking on walls, doors or furniture is strictly prohibited. Offenders will be punished according to college rules.
7. Fund raising for any purpose is not allowed without prior permission from the Principal. Violators will face disciplinary action.
8. The college has a zero-tolerance policy for violence, exploitation or harassment. Such actions will be treated as criminal offenses and punished according to the law.
9. Organizing meetings, distributing materials, or displaying posters/banners inside the campus without permission is prohibited. Permission must be sought from the administration if needed.
10. The use of mobile phones, gadgets, or other electronic devices on campus is not allowed. Devices found will be confiscated.
11. Smoking, chewing tobacco, consuming alcohol, or using narcotic substances are strictly prohibited. Criminal proceedings will be initiated against violators.
12. Ragging, in any form, is strictly prohibited both on and off-campus. Any involvement in ragging will result in punishment according to UGC and Government guidelines.
13. Misconduct, cheating, bribing or providing false information is strictly prohibited.
14. Students must inform the college if they leave during the session.
15. Students are only allowed to park their vehicles in the designated parking area; entry beyond this point is prohibited.
16. Students are advised not to engage in activities that may harm the college's reputation, including discussions or trolling. Legal action will be taken against those found guilty.
17. If a student is found to have used fraudulent means for admission or provided incorrect information, their admission will be cancelled at

any stage.

18. Any errors or omissions discovered during the document verification process will lead to the cancellation of admission.
19. Late, incomplete or improperly filled applications will not be accepted.
20. The college has not appointed any consultants or external agencies for admissions. Students are advised to directly contact the Admission & Counselling Office for assistance.
21. Students are encouraged to regularly check the notice boards for important updates.

### STUDENT UNION ELECTION POLICY

The college prohibits any political activities on campus, including student union elections.

1. Parents and guardians are requested to cooperate with the college authorities.

### HIGH COURT DIRECTIVE ON ATTENDANCE

As per the High Court's order, all students are required to maintain 75% attendance in classes to be eligible to appear as a regular student in the University Examination.
